The PAP's track record

- To push for women's development and protection of women, PAP Women's Wing launched the **#ActionforHer** social movement to garner public support and push for change on women's development and protection of women
- The **Action for Green Towns** initiative was introduced across all PAP-towns to move our towns towards zero-waste, energy efficient and greener towns by 2025.
 - In 2023, all PAP wards have planted more than 49,000 trees and shrubs, and collected over 770,000kg of e-waste, as part of the Action for Green Towns initiative.
- The **#BetterTogether** movement was launched in 2022 to raise greater awareness of mental health issues, and drive collective action to uplift one another in our society.
- Young PAP published the 'Singapore: A Green Hub' position paper with suggestions
 to tackle climate change, with an updated second edition of the paper and a 'Climate
 Action Strategy', following consultations with industry representatives to assess the
 feasibility of the suggestions.
- Our Government Parliamentary Committees (GPCs) and Members of Parliament continue to push for change with key parliamentary motions, including:
 - The GPC for Communication and Information led a 2024 motion to advocate for an inclusive and safe digital society for all Singaporeans.
 - The GPC for Health, with MP Edward Chia, led a motion in 2024 calling for a whole-of-nation effort to enhance mental health and well-being in Singapore.
 - In 2021 and 2022, the GPC for Sustainability and the Environment raised motions with a call to action to deepen and accelerate efforts to mitigate and adapt to climate change, and to embrace sustainability in the development of Singapore. Their motion heeded the recommendations put forth in the position papers of the Young PAP.
 - Members of the GPC for Transport also raised key suggestions and clarifications during the debate on the Transport Sector (Critical Firms) Bill
 - GPC Chair for Sustainability and the Environment Louis Ng will be tabling an upcoming Private Member's Bill – the Good Samaritan Food Donation Bill, to tackle food waste.
